Many online events have been organized by DISARM partners.

For example, in the webinar "Principles of Biosecurity and use of Biocheck.Ugent", presented by Prof. Jeroen Dewulf, Ghent University, you can learn the general principles of preventing the entry and spread of disease on livestock farms. Plus, find out more about the Biocheck tool, a scoring system which allows objective quantification of the quality of biosecurity measures taken on a farm and shows areas for improvement.

#### Cross visits for farmers: opportunities to discover the best solutions for improving livestock health and AMR reduction
